

## **Interreg Project Manager (Part Time)**

### **For the Interreg IVA France (Channel) – England Programme - Monitoring Manche Mammals and their Habitats Project**

**Remuneration £120 per day for 60 days in total across ~15 months**

The Cornwall Red Squirrel Project (CRSP), as lead partner in the **Monitoring Manche Mammals and their Habitats Project**, are seeking an experienced Interreg Project Manager. This post is for 15 months at approximately.

This project aims to enable the exchange of ideas and best practice about the monitoring, surveying and conservation of forest mammals in the Manche zone between two biogeographically similar areas. The cross-border partners, CRSP and Groupe Mammalogique Breton (GMB) seek to learn from each other about monitoring techniques, surveying techniques, recording strategies, public engagement, habitat management and practical mammal management.

CRSP and GMB have been working together for over eighteen months to develop this project which has been presented to the Interreg IVA France (Channel) – England Programme in a request for funding.

This is a crucial project for CRSP and we are looking for someone with a strong track record of managing and delivering successful Interreg projects. We are keen that the Project Manager should have experience and understanding of the Interreg IVA France (Channel) – England Programme. This post also requires a person who:-

- Has an understanding of the issues being addressed in this project.
- Can work closely with the project partners in both France and Cornwall to deliver this project to time and quality.
- Can provide project management support, specifically supporting the delivery of financial, legal, audit, monitoring and evaluation systems as appropriate.
- Can ensure financial claims and reporting complies with both EU and the managing authority's systems.
- Can work independently.
- Can work flexibly including evenings and weekends.
- Has a full driving licence and own transport.
